

Class Descriptions: All Purebreds, Fullbloods, and Recorded Percentage entries must be tattooed as per CSA registration paper.

- A. Purebred Heifer Calf, born on or after Jan.1, 2009
 - a. Registered/tattooed purebred or fullblood Simmental female
- B. Purebred Yearling Female, born on or after Jan 1, 2008
 - a. Registered/tattooed purebred or fullblood Simmental female
 - b. Note: pick either class B or C, not both**
- C. Purebred Bred & Owned Yearling Female, born on or after Jan 1, 2008
 - a. Registered/tattooed purebred or fullblood Simmental female
 - b. Exhibitor must be breeder & present owner of entry as verifiable on the CSA registration paper**
 - c. Note: pick either class B or C, not both**
- D. Purebred 2 yr Old Female, born on or after Jan. 1, 2007
 - b. Registered/tattooed purebred or fullblood Simmental female
 - c. Natural 2007 registered/tattooed purebred or fullblood calf must be shown at side
- E. Purebred Mature Female, born on or before Dec. 31,2006
 - d. Registered/tattooed purebred or fullblood Simmental female
 - e. Natural 2007 registered/tattooed purebred or fullblood calf must be shown at side
- F. Purebred Bull Calf, born on or after Jan.1, 2009
 - f. Registered/tattooed purebred or fullblood Simmental male
- G. Commercial Heifer Calf, born on or after Jan. 1, 2009
 - g. Crossbred/Percentage Simmental Female or CSA Recorded percentage female
 - h. Entry must display Simmental characteristics
- H. Commercial Yearling Female, born on or after Jan. 1, 2008
 - i. Crossbred/Percentage Simmental Female or CSA Recorded percentage female
 - j. Entry must display Simmental characteristics
- I. Commercial Bull Calf, born on or after Jan. 1, 2009
 - k. Crossbred/Percentage Simmental or CSA Recorded percentage male
 - l. Entry must display Simmental characteristics
- J. Participants NOT bringing Cattle.
 - m. Eligible to compete in all events except Conformation.

- 1. Participants in Regional Classics are not required to hold an individual YCSA membership. Membership is encouraged.
- 2. Participants in the National Classic are required to hold an individual YCSA membership.
- 3. Participants must be 25 years and younger as of January 1st of the competition year.
- 4. Contestants must compete in Judging, Herdsman Quiz and Sire Summary Quiz at the scheduled competition time to be eligible for Showmanship and Conformation Classes.
- 5. Ties will be broken by comparing scores in the following events.
 - a. 1st Tie-breaker = Sire Summary
 - b. 2nd Tie-breaker = Herdsman Quiz
 - c. 3rd Tie-breaker = Judging Contest.
- 6. Novice, Junior, Intermediate, and Senior division eligibility.
 - a. Novice: 10 years and under as of January 1st of the competition year.
 - b. Junior: 11-14 years as of January 1st of the competition year.
 - c. Intermediate: 15-17 as of January 1st of the competition year.
 - d. Senior: 18-25 as of January 1st of the competition year.
- 7. Conduct:
 - a. All competitors in attendance of Classics are expected to conduct themselves with dignity and respect.
 - b. Violations include, but are not limited to: misrepresentation of animals, vandalism, theft, fighting, unsportsmanlike conduct, failure to comply with directives of officials, being in possession of or under the influence of **alcohol** or other prohibited substances while on the **competition grounds** and/or in **public areas**.
 - c. Violations of these standards will result in immediate review by the Hearing Committee.
- 8. No artificial filling of animals will be allowed unless under the advice of a licensed, non-owner, veterinarian. Violation will result in immediate review by the Hearing Committee.
- 9. All livestock entries must be stalled by the published move-in time on the published move-in date. Livestock release follows the awards ceremony.

10. Ownership Rules

- a. All entries in the **Bred & Owned** division must be registered as such under the entrants' name. A copy of the CSA registration paper must be provided during event registration.
- b. All entries, excluding Bred & Owned, must be **registered to the entrant, entrants immediate family or entrants immediate family farm, or registered as a 4H project of the entrant**. A copy of the CSA registration paper or 4H certificate must be provided during event registration.
